Course description

The **musician's artistic interpretation and health** should be in harmony, because only a healthy body can offer musicians the necessary basis for a lifetime of optimal performance on the piano. Participants are therefore expressly requested to consider their own or others' experiences with the psychic and physical problems of professional musicianship, e.g., playing problems or practicing difficult passages. Practical relevance has priority!

The **exchange of experience** is part of the course, and therefore the course will be structured on the basis of questions and problems brought up by participants. Individual instruction is also possible by arrangement.

In addition to **artistic piano playing**, the course will also illuminate musicians' health. This includes, e.g., the optimization of practice methods and the sensitization of consciousness, whereby aspects such as bodily awareness, posture, breathing, as well as muscle strain and relaxation while playing the piano are of great significance. Through special **physical exercises** that are offered in the course, participants should become aware of these aspects, and thereby prevention is emphasized (music physiology). Thereby the connection of sound and playing movements, as well as the training of the "inner ear," is important. **Hearing guides movement**, and a full, rich sound (be it on the piano or pianoforte) correlates with effortless but effective movement.

The course is oriented to advanced pupils, university and music academy students, piano teachers and professional pianists.
